Present Language

VI. Finance

Old & New Language Combined

VI. Finance

2. The expenses of the Association shall be met from voluntary contributions solicited from the Congregational Christian Churches in response to recommendations from the Executive Committee, ~~and also~~ from such receipts as may come to the Association in its meetings or through special gifts and legacies, **and from yearly contributions to the Shared Ministries Fund from active member Churches.**

Proposed New Language for Vote

The Executive Committee proposes that Section VI, Paragraph 2., of the Bylaws of the Association be amended to read as follows:
